
INREV Vehicles Universe


The INREV Vehicles Universe reached 585 vehicles at the end of March 2025 with a total gross asset value (GAV) of €483.5 billion. This quarter's release includes nine more active vehicles than last quarter's release. Seven vehicle launches were reported in 2023, seven in 2024 and two in 2025.


The traditional property sectors industrial/logistics, office, residential and retail account for 86% of the single sector vehicles in the Universe by GAV. Industrial/logistics represents only 13% by number of all single sector vehicles, but 29% by GAV.

300 funds follow a single country strategy, of which 75% focus on the four main geographies. The Germany focused funds have the largest representation in the Universe amongst single country focused funds, at 35%.


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
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Universe composition by vintage year
